On Wednesday, May 31st, 2017 from 8:15-10am in the Hall we will have our shows for 1st, 3rd, and 4th grade. They are as follows:

- 1st: Coyote Steals Summer
- 3rd: Alice's Adventures with Idioms
- 4th: California Missions

On Thursday, June 1st, 2017 from 8:15-10am in the hall we will have our shows for Kinder, 2nd, and 5th. They are as follows:

- Kinder: American Symbols
- 2nd: Little Red Riding Hood
- 5th: Munchkin Mediation: Conflict Resolution in Oz

Tickets for the student morning shows in the morning will be \$5 each. Children under the age of three are free as long as they are lap sitting. There will be general seating and tickets are available at the door the day of the show.

You are responsible for your child's costume for the grade level shows. Our goal is always to do the best you can without going crazy on costumes. You are welcome to look for costumes in stores and be creative, but please do not feel obligated to spend a ton of money on them. Usually by looking at home and being creative you can come up with a pretty inexpensive, but good-looking costume for your child.

COSTUMES

KINDERGARTEN

Everyone will be wearing blue jeans with black shoes (casual like sneakers or tennis). If some of the storytellers would like to wear dresses, then they can wear dress shoes. Black socks (unless you are wearing dress shoes then white will work).

STORYTELLERS: Can wear a red, white, or blue shirt or blouse (can be a combination of the colors). Can also wear a red, white, or blue dress.

AMERICAN FLAG: Students that are not storytellers, statue of liberty, liberty bell, or a bald eagle, will make up an American flag and will wear red, white, and blue shirts. Please wait for additional info once the cast list comes out!

STATUE OF LIBERTY: Green Roman toga with a torch of some sort. (You can dye a sheet and use it)

LIBERTY BELL: Silver shirt or dress (if not gray or white shirt, or dress is fine).

BALD EAGLES: Brown shirts with brown pants. You can make a yellow beak and some wings if you would like!

1ST GRADE: COYOTE STEALS SUMMER

SKY SPIRITS: White dresses or white shirt and slacks (think 1st communion dress)

COYOTE: Brown or Multi-color dress or shirt and dark pants. Hair can be put in pigtails.

OAK TREES: Brown shirt and brown pants (twigs can be attached to a headband for headpiece)

RABBITS: White, Brown, or gray shirt or dress, blue jeans. Put ears on a headband.

FOXES: Orange Shirts or dress, brown pants, a tail (can be made with paper) and some ears.

EAGLES: Brown pants and brown shirt with wings and a beak.

TIPI FOLK: Brown Indian looking attire.

2ND GRADE: LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD

STORYTELLERS: Nice shirt and tie with black slacks. Girls can wear nice dresses or blouses.

MRS. RED RIDING HOOD: Simple country style dress with apron.

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD: Red dress (or it can be another color) with a red cape in the back of it. A basket.

TOWNSPEOPLE: Overalls or jeans and black t-shirts.

FLOWER FAMILY: Spring Dresses (with flowers on them would make it even better!)

SQUIRRELS: Brown shirt and brown pants. Fluffy tail made out of stuffed stockings (if possible), whiskers can be painted and ears attached to baseball cap or headband.

GRANNY RIDING HOOD: A nightgown and cap with large numbers attached to it (these numbers can be pinned on and made of paper).

WOLF: Baseball cap with menacing cardboard teeth attached beneath bill. Eyes and ears of cardboard attached to top of cap. Gray or brown clothes.

WOODSMEN: Safari style hat, short pants and hiking boots (If possible).

JUNIOR TRACKERS: T-shirts, short pants and hiking boots (If possible). They can have hiking accessories like a water bottle, backpack, and a butterfly net.

3RD GRADE: ALICE'S ADVENTURES WITH IDIOMS

ALICE: Blue dress with white apron and blue bow.

DINAH, HER CAT: Brownish/Red cat with blue eyes and an pink bow and ears.

MICAH, HER DOG: Dog costume any dog color, add ears.

WHITE RABBITS: White and pink rabbit ears, time clock, umbrellas, blue pants, yellow and red shirts.

TWEEDLEDEE AND TWEEDLEDUM: Red pants, yellow shirts, blue and white bowties, red hats with yellow flags on top.

CATERPILLARS: Blue pants and shirts, or dress, pink mittens.

DUCESS: Renaissance looking villager dress.

SERVANTS: Red or Black capes with cards on them (hearts, diamonds, spades, clubs).

MAD HATTER: Larger green hat, green pants and shirt with green bow.

MARCH HARE: Brown and pink rabbit ears, red shirt with orange jacket.

DOORMOUSE: Pink hat and jacket, purple top with brown pants, can have a tail.

FLAMINGO: Pink shirt and pants, or dress.

HEDGEHOG: Brown or green or yellow shirt and pants.

QUEEN OF HEARTS: Red, black, and gold dress, gold crown.

CHESHIRE CATS: Pink and purple shirt/pants, or dress, tail and ears.

KING OF HEARTS: Red royal rob with a gold crown.

PROSECUTORS: Nice clothes with judge look. Can have a gavel.

4TH GRADE: CALIFORNIA MISSIONS

NATIVE AMERICANS: Brown Indian looking attire.

JOSEPH DE GÁLVEZ: Rich Spanish Dress attire (red pants, white shirt, with blue coat.

ADMINISTRATORS: Nice dress, suit, or dress pants and dress shirt.

JUNIPERO SERRA: Brown Franciscan attire.

CAPTAIN PORTOLÁ: Black hat, blue pants with boots, white shirt with red coat.

RANCHERO WIVES: Traditional Mexican attire.

FARMERS: Overalls and plaid shirts.

JAMES POLK: Black slacks, white shirt with nice black coat.

CALIFORNIANS: GIRLS: Long skirts, blouses, and bonnets (if you can find them), country/cowgirl look). **BOYS:** Blue Jeans with button down plaid shirt, cowboy hat (country/cowboy look).

5TH GRADE: MUNCHKIN MEDIATION: CONFLICT RESOLUTION IN OZ

MUNCHKINS: Long colorful shirts with designs on them, colorful shirts, with striped colorful long socks or tights.

WICKED WITCH OF THE EAST: Black and white striped tights or socks, red shoes. Black dress.

FLYING MONKEYS: Grey shirts/pants, blue and red vest with a hat (optional), wings.

DOROTHY: Blue and white farm girls dress, hair in braids, and a basket, red shoes.

TOTO: Terrier costume, grey and black shirt/shorts/dress.

WICKED WITCH OF THE WEST: Black dress and black pointed hat, broomstick.

GOOD WITCH OF THE NORTH: Pink or white dress, tall crown, wand.

SCARECROW: Brown pants, long green shirt, hay coming out of gloves etc, hat.

LION: Yellow/Brown costume that looks like a lion.

TIN WOODMAN: Silver shirt and pants, silver ax, and oil pan.

WIZARD: Green nice shirt and pants, large green hat. The shirt can also be a suit like shirt.

WINKIES: Long guard like clothes.
