For this project you will be picking one of the US presidents and doing research on that President. You MUST get a parental signature and put the name of the president you would like to choose. This will be a first come first get basis. Every student will have a different president they will be reporting on.

In your report you must include

- Introduction of the President
- Who he is
- Why you chose him
- Early Life
- Date and Place of Birth
- Parents and their occupations/ jobs
- Siblings (if any) and any other close family members of importance
- Education (where did they go to school)
- Importance people or events that helped to form this person's character
- Early Career(s)
- Marriage and Children (if any)
- Why this person ran for president
- The Presidency
- How many terms in office
- Political party affiliation
- Who their Vice-President was
- Important events/ acts that occurred during his Presidency
- People who influenced the president's decisions
- After their Presidency
- Place of residence
- Activities the President did after their Term
- Date and cause of death (if they died)
- Their legacy as a President
*** Students will also be preparing a 5-10 minute presentation on the President they are researching

This report must include a reference page where you cite your references.
How to cite the references are listed below

- Web Site: Author(s) if appropriate. Title of Site or web page. URL of site, date of publication (the earliest copyright year listed).
- Book: Author(s). Title of book. Edition. Location of publisher: Name of Publisher, year of publication.
- Encyclopedia: Title of encyclopedia, volume of encyclopedia used. Location of publisher: Name of Publisher, year of publication, pages where the article is located.
- Magazine or Journal: Author(s). "Title of article." Name of magazine, Volume. issue (date): pages where the article is located.
