- Chalk: Write your words outside using sidewalk chalk. (take pictures and put them in your notebook)
- Letters: Write each word as many times as there are letters in the word.
- Trace Around: Print your spelling words neatly. Take a colored pen and draw an outline around the word, closely following the shapes of the letters. Close your eyes and remember the shape.
- Colorful Words: Use two different color pens to write your spelling words. Use one color to write the consonants and the other for the vowels.
- Practice Test: Have an adult give you a practice test. (put results and test in your notebook)
- Computer Words: Have your child type their spelling words ten times each on the computer. Use different colors and fonts and print it out! (put in your notebook)
- Create an activity: Can you think of a fun way to do your spelling activities? Try it out and explain it to Ms. Mahar.
