Write 7 riddles.</p>
<p><u>spelling story</u> Use 8 of your spelling words to write a creative story.</p>	<p><u>length words</u> Count the # of letters in each word. Then write the words in order from shortest to longest.</p>	<p><u>silly words</u> Use all of your spelling words in 5 silly sentences.</p>	<p><u>ABC order</u> Write your spelling words in ABC order.</p>
<p><u>riddle me that</u> Write a riddle or question so that your spelling word is the answer. Write 7 riddles.</p>	<p><u>spelling word story</u> Use 8 of your spelling words to write a creative story.</p>	<p><u>antonyms</u> Write each spelling word. Next to each spelling word, write a word that means the opposite.</p>	<p><u>synonyms</u> Write each spelling word. Next to each spelling word, write a word that means the same.</p>
