Performers will receive their certificates.

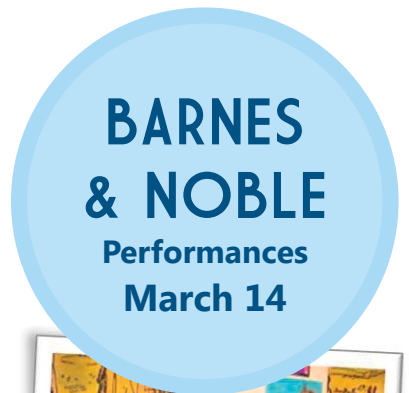
