

#### Tribes Community Agreements

St. Anthony's fosters a positive environment where every child can and will learn. One way St. Anthony's does this is through the implementation of the Tribes Community Agreements. Each student, teacher, and parent at St. Anthony's is encouraged to follow the agreements below in order to promote a culture of positivity and respect inside and outside the classroom:

- Mutual Respect
- Attentive Listening
- Appreciations/No Put Downs
- Right to Pass
- Personal Best

### CLIP CHART

To ensure that all students are following our Classroom Rules & Tribes Community Agreements, first grade will be using a <u>clip chart</u>. Students may clip up for making good choices. Students may clip down for making poor choices. Here are the colors below:

Purple-- Outstanding Day!
Blue-- Good Choices!
Green-- Ready to Learn!
Yellow-- Think About It...
Orange-- Make Better Choices...
Red-- Teacher Choice

If a student ends the day on <u>Green, Blue, or Purple</u>, they will earn <u>one point</u> for the day. If a student ends the day on <u>vellow</u>, they will earn a half a point (0.5) for the day. If a student ends the day on <u>orange or red</u>, they will earn <u>0 points</u> for the day. Behavior grades will be out of five points (unless it is a short week), and will be entered into Gradelink every Monday. **Please Note:** Students must earn an, 'O,' in both <u>Behavior and Work Habits</u> to earn <u>citizenship</u> at the end of each Trimester.

Students will keep track of their behavior throughout the week by *honestly* filling out a <u>behavior chart</u>. *Parents should sign this chart everyday* or points will be deducted. (**Please Note:** if students are *not* filling out their behavior chart *honestly*, their chart will be changed to an automatic, 'Red-- Teacher's Choice.')

I will contact families if your child ever comes home on, 'Red-- Teacher's Choice.' I am always happy to answer any questions or concerns you may have about your child's progress in my classroom. However, I want our class to learn this year how to take responsibility for our own choices, and be able to express this outside of the classroom.



If a student ends the day on <u>Green, Blue, or Purple</u>, they will earn <u>one point</u> for the day. If a student ends the day on <u>yellow</u>, they will earn a half a point (<u>0.5</u>) for the day. If a student ends the day on <u>orange or red</u>, they will earn <u>0 points</u> for the day. (**Please Note**: if students are not filling out their behavior chart honestly, their chart will be changed to an automatic, 'Red--Teacher's Choice.')

I will contact families if your child ever comes home on, 'Red-- Teacher's Choice.' I am always happy to answer any questions or concerns you may have about your child's progress in my classroom. However, I want our class to learn this year how to take responsibility for our own choices, and be able to express this outside of the classroom.

#### Homework

#### <u>Reading Log</u>

- Students should read for 20-30 minutes each night & fill out skills based reading log.
- Reading logs will be kept in a manila file folder.
- Reading logs should be returned to school *every day* in the "Return to School" pocket of your child's homework folder.
- Reading logs will be checked every day, and grades will be entered on Friday.

### Homework (Continued)

#### Go Math Practice

- Students will complete <u>two</u> math workbook pages from the *Go Math! Standards Practice Book*(that correspond to the lesson taught in class that day).
- The Go Math! Standards Practice Book will be kept at home with your child.
- Students should rip out the pages they need to complete and put their FIRST NAME, LAST NAME, AND THE DATE on each page.
- Students should *staple* each homework page together (with Monday's assignment on top) and turn their math homework in on <u>Friday only</u>.
- Math tests and quizzes will take place in the middle and at the end of each chapter.

### Homework (Continued)

#### Sight Word Practice

- Students will get a list of sight words to practice and learn each week.
- These words will be stapled on the inside of your child's composition notebook along with several activities they can do with the words.
- Students should pick <u>one</u> activity to do each night with <u>all</u> of their words. There should be one activity per page with the date on top.
- These composition notebooks should only be turned in on <u>Friday.</u>
