Dear Parents and Guardians:

We would like to congratulate your student(s) on being cast in *Aladdin Jr.*! There will be a Parent Information Meeting on Tuesday, February 12th from 6:30-7:30pm in Rm. 5 (Music Room). All parents and guardians are welcome, but please try to have at least one representative from your family.

Rehearsals will be predominately on Tuesday, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Thursday will be for choreography with Ms. Lozano (choreographer). Wednesdays, we will be working on blocking and music. In addition to rehearsals two days of the week, occasionally there will be rehearsals on other days. As we get closer to the show, rehearsals will increase in number to make sure we are ready to perform. Attached is a detailed schedule and cast list that lists when students need to be at rehearsal.

If there are any conflicts, please clear them with me ASAP. If you are double cast, you need to check into rehearsal and may leave once your counterpart has arrived (On days the other cast performs). Please take a look at the attached rehearsal schedule. **Once again, these rehearsals are required unless they are cleared with me via email or the form below.**

There are two shows this year on **Friday, May 31st, 2019 and Saturday, June 1, 2019 at 7pm** in the Hall. All students are required to attend both shows unless they are double cast. If a student is double cast, they must check in with me on the date they do not perform to make sure we do not need them to perform. Tickets will be available to purchase in May. To promote the show, we are asking that each family try to sell ten tickets (or more), to our show (more information to come on this).

This year, there will be a \$40 fee to be in the show. This includes cost for the actor's script, music CD, part of the show rights, and for our lunch on Monday, May 27th. Please pay this fee in the office to Mr. Aguilar.

You will be required to buy or create costumes for your students. I will provide you guidelines and ideas and then it will be your responsibility to create them. As always, we want to have the students looking fantastic while spending the least amount of money possible. **Costumes are due to Mrs. Garcia on Thursday, April 11.**
