

# **Tuition Contract Updates**

Minimum Wage increase: \$13/hr, Jan 2020, then \$14/hr Jan 2021, then \$15/hr by 2022.

To keep up with wages and inflation, we need to increase tuition, maintenance, repairs, upgrades, retaining teachers: pay well

\$12,000 to educate a child in CA each year in public schools, our tuition is less than half of that so we offer more to students for less money.

### Referral Incentives

- Ongoing Referral incentives for families: \$75/\$75 Scrip (Decand June) refer families who remain in good standing. Per family, not per child. Please ask the office for this.

# Looking ahead (re-registration)

IMPORTANT EARLY REGISTRATION and RE-REGISTRATION INFO for RETURNING FAMILIES FOR the 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR!

Current families can re-register on 2/18 (A-K last names) and 2/19 (L-Z last names) from 6-8pm in the Hall. Secure your child/ren('s) spot for next year, or you may be placed on the wait list. All tuition contracts and parent handbook forms must be signed at re-registration. Non-refundable registration Fees are: \$150/child: returning students and \$175/child for new students and LATE registrants. If you need to apply for tuition assistance next year, please speak to Mr. Aguilar. You may pre-pay for registration fees in the office and fill out the re-registration packets ahead of time on a fillable PDF, to expedite your time in the hall on your assigned night. Families must sign up for their 8 Fiesta Hours, and can do so starting with Patty Sanchez at our General Parent Meeting on 2/6, then again on 2/18 and 2/19

## Extended Care Updates

- REALITY: Teen Babysitters are \$12/hr, minimum wage is \$13/hour, Our fee is \$8/day for after school care. This can't sustain with rising wage
- We do this as a service to parents, it's a mini school fundraiser but it has to make sense. In years past, it made money, if we continue at this rate we will be at a loss. All programs need to be sustainable.
- If we had an outside vendor come in to take care of extended care after school next year, who would sign up? What if we discontinued the program, who would that affect? Many students are leaving after our programs, and this is affecting the daycare income...
- We have 2 possible vendors who can offer morning and afternoon extended daycare on campus for an hourly rate.
