## **CROSSOVER DAY**


- June 3, 2020 at 10:00am (tomorrow)



## Reminders about Tuition for 2020-2021

- Minimum Wage increase: \$13/hr, Jan 2020, then \$14/hr Jan 2021, then \$15/hr by 2022.
- To keep up with wages and inflation, we need to increase tuition, maintenance, repairs, upgrades, to retain teachers we must pay them well
- It costs \$12,000 to educate a child in CA each year in public schools
- Tuition at St. Anthony of Padua is less than half of that, so we offer more to our families for less money spent per child. Our ADLA leaders and Archbishop recently spoke to President Trump and Education Secretary re: School Choice vouchers. Pray this gets passed!
- Four General Parent Meetings (one retreat with Msgr. Sal in November), 30 service hours per your tuition contract, 8 Fiesta Hours

### **ATTENTION: JUNIOR HIGH PARENTS**

WHAT TO LOOK FORWARD TO IN JUNIOR HIGH:

- Different Schedule: Block schedule for grades 6-8
- Several Teachers for your child: 5 teachers instead of 3 (Math, Religion/ELA, History/Science, PE, and Music)
- More demanding schedule: stay organized, Read 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens over the summer
- Different activities: Sports, Musical, Student Government, Retreats
- High Expectations: high school-prep, college- prep note taking, more collaboration on projects
- Theology of the Body/Chastity Education Program
- School technology: Seesaw app for grades K-2, Google Classrooms for grades 3-8, Mind Mapping, presentations on iPads and Chromebooks, students in grades 3-8 have school email addresses.

## ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

- More rigorous grading system: 93% and above for an A
- **College Bound:** College Fair, (researching high schools/colleges, guest speakers)
- WASC/WCEA 6 years accreditation earned in 2014, WCEA Visit Fall 2020
- **STAR Testing** (3 times a year at every trimester) District benchmark is higher than the public school benchmark
- C.I.P. (Core Instructional Practices) used in all classes K-8
- Accelerated Reader (AR)
- **Differentiated programs:** Freckle: Math and ELA
- **STEP Program:** the private school equivalent to an IEP or Individualized Education Plan based on student needs (academic contracts created as needed)
- ST Math: adaptive math program supplementing Common Core math program
- **TRIBES agreements:** Character education initiative (see website for more info)
- **Positivity Project:** P2 (positive character traits emphasized)
- **Rick Morris Sign Language** used in grades K-8 (see website for more info)
- **Graduation rate is 100%,** majority of students attend local Catholic high schools.

### **CONCERNS ABOUT YOUR CHILD?**

Here is the proper procedure/Chain of Command:

- Contact and Speak to your **child's teacher first**. (This includes P.E. teacher, Music teacher, etc.)
- Work with teacher to solve the problem (Open-door policy)
- If needed, teacher or parent will contact administration to assist with any situation. Parent involvement and partnership is vital.
- **Presume "Positive" Intentions:** Teamwork/Trust is paramount
- School Meeting Norms: maximize our time together

## SAFETY AND LOGISTICS

- All of you will receive emergency cards: please update all information at front office should anything change
- Most important: Emergency Card. Children will ONLY be released to those on this card. Please fill out both sides carefully and legibly.
- Routine emergency drills (once a month) for earthquake, lockdown, fire
- All medical records/special needs must reported to the office and teachers. Any allergies? Be specific please.
- Any medications need to be accompanied by Medication Authorization and Medication Form

## SAFETY AND LOGISTICS (CONT)

- Your child is sick or absent? Call or email the office and your student's homeroom Teacher!
- **BE ON TIME...or it affects work habits grade**
- If Distance Learning continues, students are expected to wear uniforms and follow Zoom guidelines
- Parents are asked to sign up on the Remind App so they can be reached quickly in case of emergency.
- Please keep sick students at home until they are healthy and have a plan for picking up a student who becomes sick at school. This is to ensure the health and safety of our entire school community.

## **COMMUNICATION IS KEY**

- Please be informed parents. You are your child's first teacher. Ask clarifying questions, get involved.
- Check Website often www.stanthonygardena.org
- Gradelink (teachers will hand out login info and Back to School night packet in September) Get grade notifications on your phone (high or low grades). Work on this in your Settings. Your children can learn to take ownership of learning by checking grades often and communicating with teachers directly.
- YOU MAKE A DIFFERENCE! Your child will thank you.

## DAYCARE INFORMATION

- Flat rate: \$12/day per child
- \$8/day per child if student is coming from any after school activity
- Please note there is a **5-minute grace period** for students coming from an after-school activity before the \$8/day fee is charged so please pick students up promptly.
- \$1/per minute late fee for any student picked up after 6PM
- Evening Daycare is contingent upon having adequate staff available
- Any younger siblings brought to evening meetings must be potty-trained (this is all dependent on reopening and health guidelines)

## DAYCARE REMINDERS

**Exceptions – Afternoon Care WILL NOT be available on the following days** 

- The Wednesday before Thanksgiving
- The Friday when Christmas Vacation begins
- Holy Thursday
- The Wednesday before Fiesta (when Fiesta takes place)
- The Last day of School

Daycare is available until only 3 PM on the following dates:

- Halloween
- The Monday and Tuesday before the Parish Fiesta (when Fiesta takes place)

### LOOKING AHEAD

- Every year is different, remote learning or staggered classes may have to take place in the fall. Please wait for updates. We will email blast this info to everyone once we have more info from the Dept. of Catholic Schools (DCS). We will not be following exact same guidelines as LAUSD, but will be guided by Catholic values and the health department.
- To promote distance and blended learning, all Grades (K-8) will need to have a device (iPad, Chromebook for distance learning. See K-2 Supply lists
