Detects changes in your body's temperature trends & sends alerts



WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

Most COVID-19 positive individuals have a fever that is not detected using CDC guidelines (greater than 100.4° F) ¹

Daily temperature monitoring can detect the hidden fever up to one week before peak symptoms appear

Early detection with the arc.health sensor gives you up to a seven day headstart on treatment and infection control, slowing the spread of COVID-19

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is it safe? Yes, there is no battery or risk of injury

Is it secure? Yes, all personal data is encrypted

Where do I wear it? With two sensors: wear on the back or chest & wrist

DETECTING THE HIDDEN FEVER¹

Researchers at Brown University and the Department of Veterans Affairs conducted a study assessing the average daily temperature of over 7,000 nursing home residents prior to and after COVID-19 testing.

They found that 73.4% of patients testing positive for SARS-CoV-2, never had a fever higher than 100.4° degrees Fahrenheit.

A single screening for temperature is unlikely to detect nursing home residents with SARS-CoV-2. Repeated temperature measurement with a patient-derived baseline can increase sensitivity.




Fig. 1 Temperature in nursing home residents with and without SARS-CoV-2. The graph depicts daily temperature before negative days) and after (positive days) the testing for SARS-CoV-2 (T0). The shaded area represents the 95% confidence intervals.

Even though things are fluid during this time of COVID, we are financially viable! We currently have a balanced budget and are operating in the black. Thank you for continuing to support our school!




Campus Updates




