VERY IMPORTANT: When registering, you will have the option to support a specific grade. Please make sure to select accordingly. Also, each adult can only have one registration. Multiple accounts are not permitted for each adult. EFG reserves the right to disqualify school earnings on completed brand opinions from alias accounts.

TROJAN DRAWING entries will be earned as follows:

Your child's name be entered into our Wednesday "Trojan drawing" for every 75 brand opinions completed. When a registered adult completes 75, they become a SUPERSTAR contributor. Parents/guardians will be responsible with providing us a list of their family and friends that have completed their 75 brand opinions and have achieved SUPERSTAR status. SUPERSTARS receive an email when this is achieved. No Screenshots please. Just the name of the adult, student's name and grade is all we need. SERVICE HOURS

Families also have the unique opportunity this year to earn some of their service hours. Each family is required to complete your required service hours. This school year's requirement was adjusted from 30 hours to 20 hours. This opportunity was made available by Mrs. Grey as an effort to help our families during the pandemic and still be able to support the school from home.

For every SUPERSTAR (an adult that has completed 75 brand opinions) you can earn the following:

Frequently asked questions:

My family completed 60 brand opinions; will my child be entered into the Trojan Drawing? How many service hours will I earn?

Trojan Drawing Entries are earned for every 75 brand opinions completed. Your family's completed brand opinions/ opinions will earn our school \$2.00 x 60 brand opinions for a total of \$120, but unfortunately your child's name will not be put into the drawing. 2.5 service hours are earned only at SUPERSTAR status (75 brand opinions completed). We highly encourage you to have your family and friends complete the maximum 75 brand opinions to earn maximum benefits!

Can I earn all my service hours this year from this campaign?

This is a very unique opportunity as this is also our first time running this particular fundraiser and the school made special modifications. There is no maximum of service hours that can be earned this year, but for next year there may be a cap to the number of hours earned. We urge families to take advantage of this opportunity to complete service hours. There will be no adjustments made for incomplete service hours this year since we have this in place.

Do I have to participate in this campaign?

In lieu of our annual Jog-A-Thon and the school Annual Social, this has been slotted in its place. We are asking each family to complete 75 brand opinions by at least one parent/guardian in your family to fulfill the requirement outlined on your tuition contract. If you do not participate, **the school office will be invoicing your family the \$100 for the Jog-A-Thon fees on Wednesday, March 3rd, 2021.**

I completed 75 brand opinions and got my SUPERSTAR email confirmation. What now?

Please email the name of your SUPERSTAR, email address used, name of student supported, the student's grade to the PLC Co-Chairs, Angelic and Leah (our email information is below). We will enter your child into the Trojan drawing and credit your service hours in Gradelink once this has been verified by the reports we received from Express Feedback. You can continue to complete the brand opinions with your registered email but your financial impact for the school has been maximized. We urge you to continue remind your family and friends with their registered emails to earn their SUPERSTAR status so that your family can continue to earn Trojan drawing entries and service hours.

Can I do all 75 brand opinions in one day? Can I do a little bit every day?

There is a maximum of 50 completed brand opinions per day. You can continue to revisit the link from your registered email address that EFG sent to you and do a little bit each day. Remember to complete SUPERSTAR status for our Trojan drawing and prizes as outlined on the 1st page of this correspondence.

I had my family do a total of 75 brand opinions among 5 family members on 5 different emails. Will I earn service hours and my child's entry into the Trojan drawing? Will I get invoiced for the \$100 in JAT fees?

Only SUPERSTARS (those adult family members that have completed all 75 brand opinions with ONE email address) will earn a Trojan Drawing entry and 2.5 service hours. Please see the section "SERVICE HOURS" on the 1st page of this correspondence for breakdown on how you can earn entries and hours. If there is one "SUPERSTAR" in the family, you WILL NOT be invoiced for JAT (Jog a Thon) fees of \$100.

I did 40 brand opinions and I understand that I will get invoiced for JAT fees because I did not complete 75 brand opinions and achieve SUPERSTAR status. Does our class and school still earn the \$2 per survey?

Yes, the school will earn \$2 for each of the brand opinions completed, in this case \$80 total. Your class totals will also reflect that they earned \$80 and will count towards class earning totals. For Top Family Prizes, however, our reports received from EFG (Express Feedback for Good) only show SUPERSTARS (those adult family members that have completed all 75 brand opinions with ONE email address). This list is what the fundraising committee will use to determine top family prizes. We do not capture any participant's information for contributions under the 75 completed brand opinions, so we do not have the ability to add up brand opinions from emails that have not achieved SUPERSTAR status. Again, for maximum earnings, we encourage everyone to complete the goal of 75 brand opinions per participant.

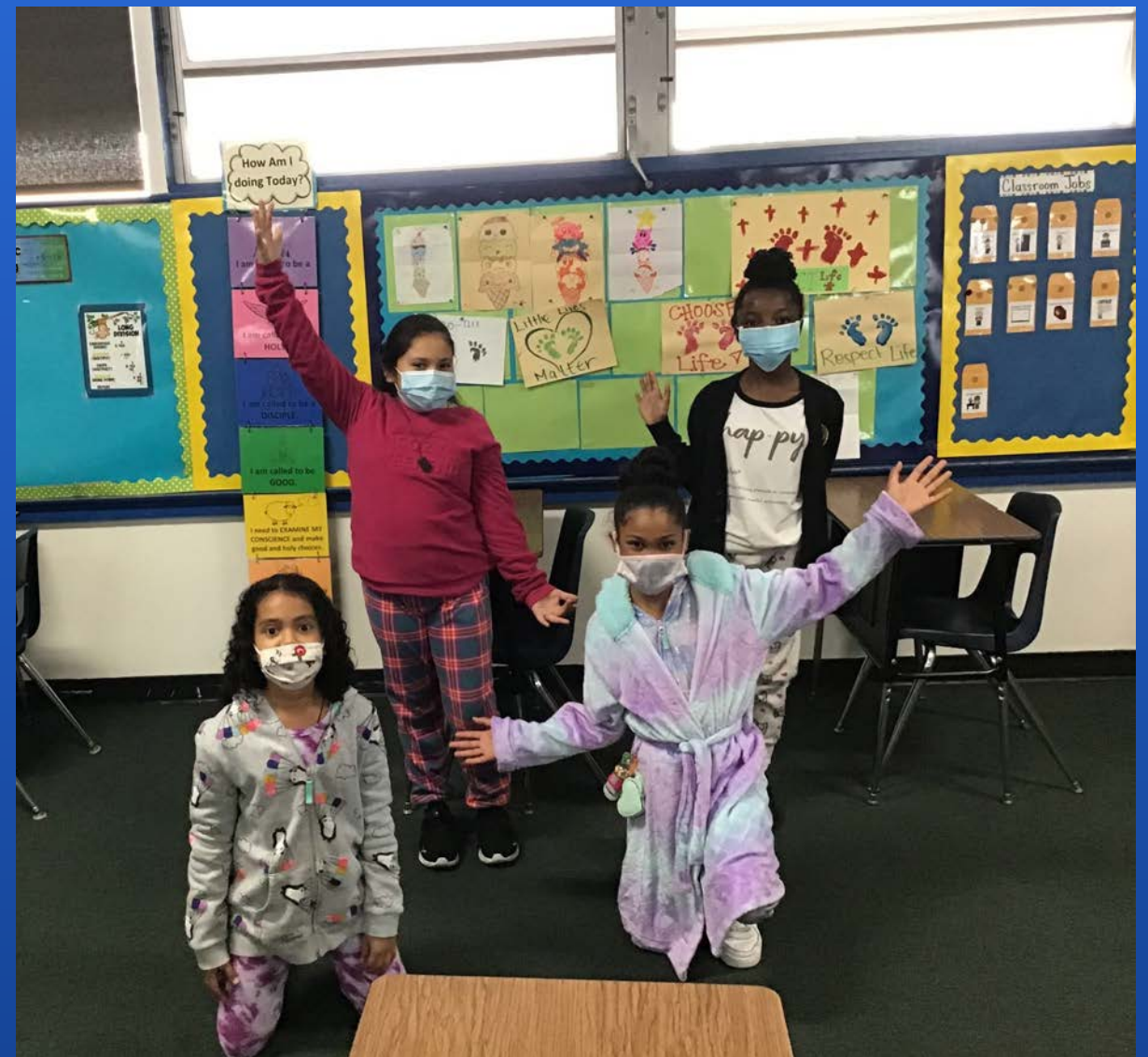

Sports Updates from Athletic Director, Ms. Mahar

We can start registering basketball teams but naturally, the DCS will have to approve this activity which will likely depend on if/when students are back on campus.

The CYO sports have allowed conditioning and working out as long as the students are not scrimmaging or touching each other.

CYO Basketball season planning will remain fluid, but at the ready to resume under these conditions:

Payment deferred until season confirmed

A (7/8), B (5/6) & C (3/4) Level Participation

Teams will be limited to two teams at each level for both Boys & Girls.

All games to be played at school facilities on campus or secured off-site locations (if needed)

No Centralized games. No Facility Fees.

All games shall be played outdoors, until cleared to play in gyms.



Sports (Continued)

Games scheduled during the week and/ weekends.

CYO desires at least two games be scheduled each day to accommodate referees.

Schools may merge teams if short on players to field a team. Must be in proximity to each other and not displace any players.

Schools will pay Referees on site. CYO will provide assistance in securing officials.

Valid PLC Coaches cards required. Online classes will be offered.

A (7/8) Level Playoffs will be regionally structured and limited to fewer teams.

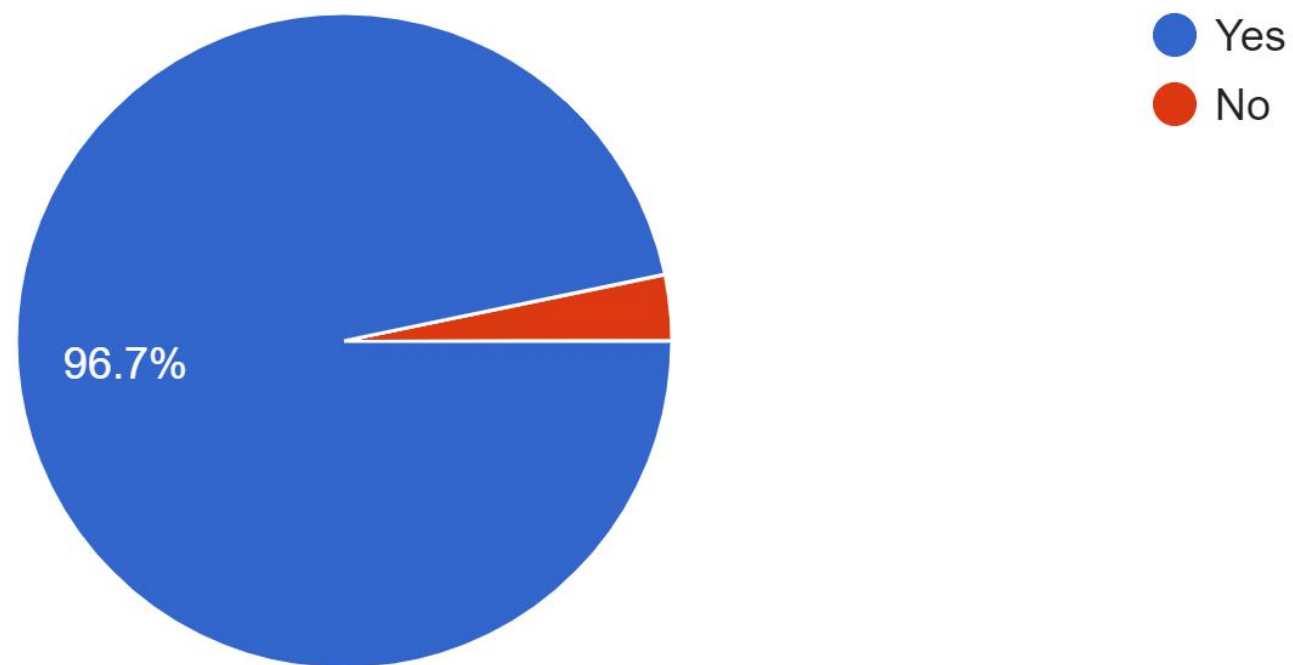

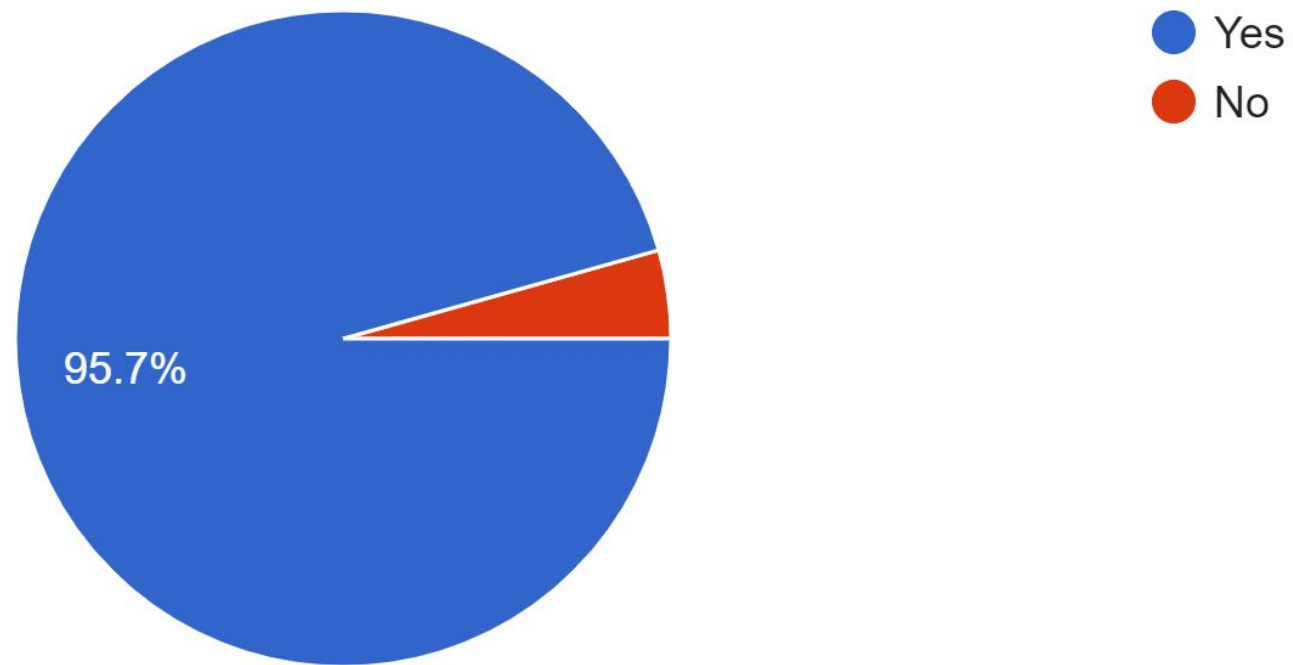

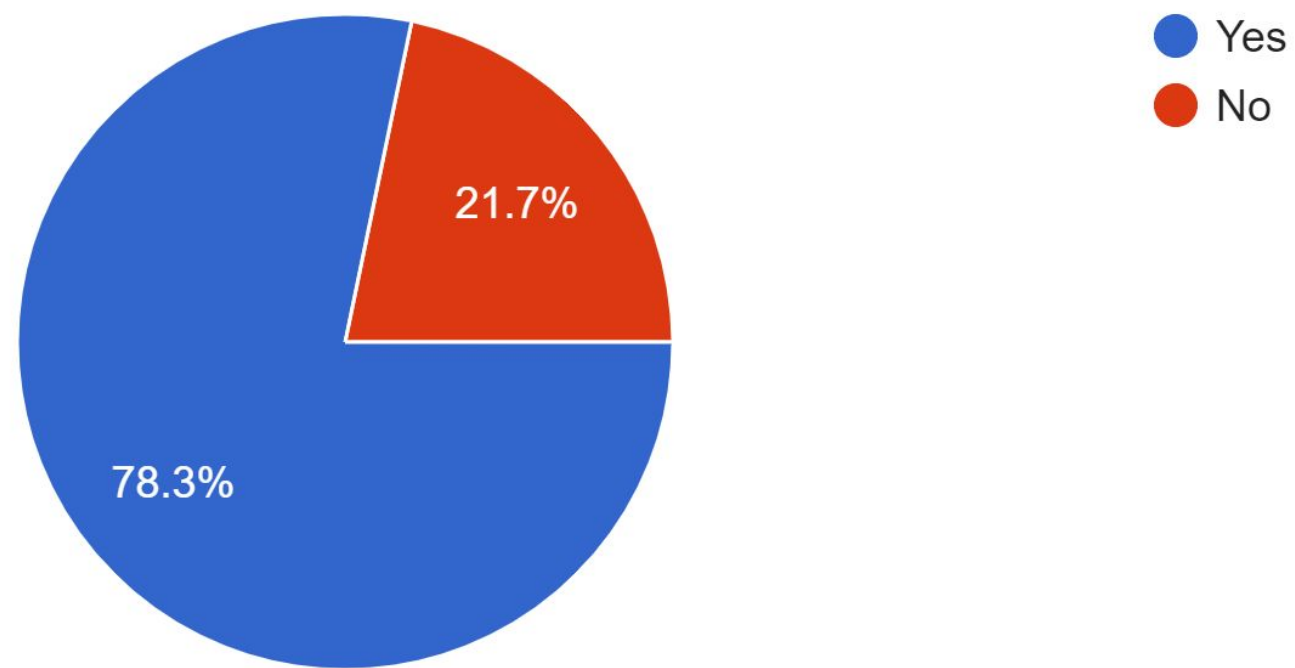

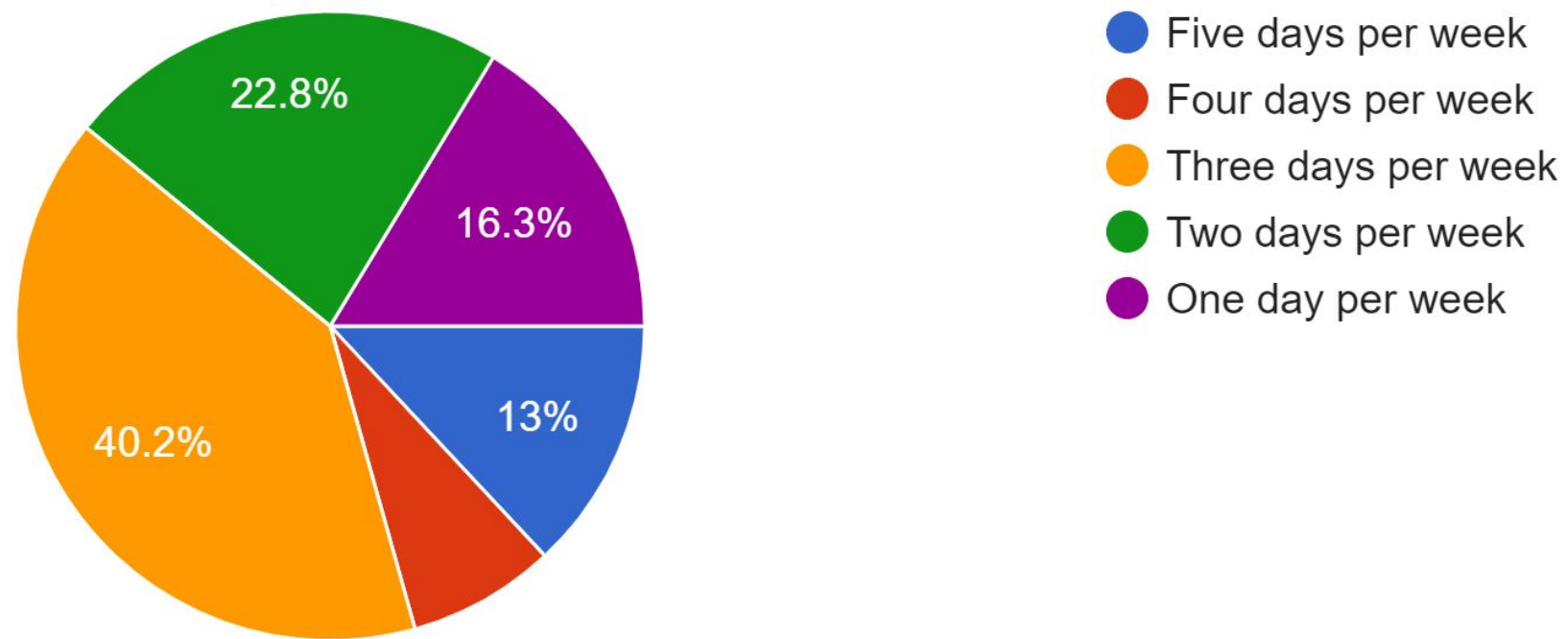

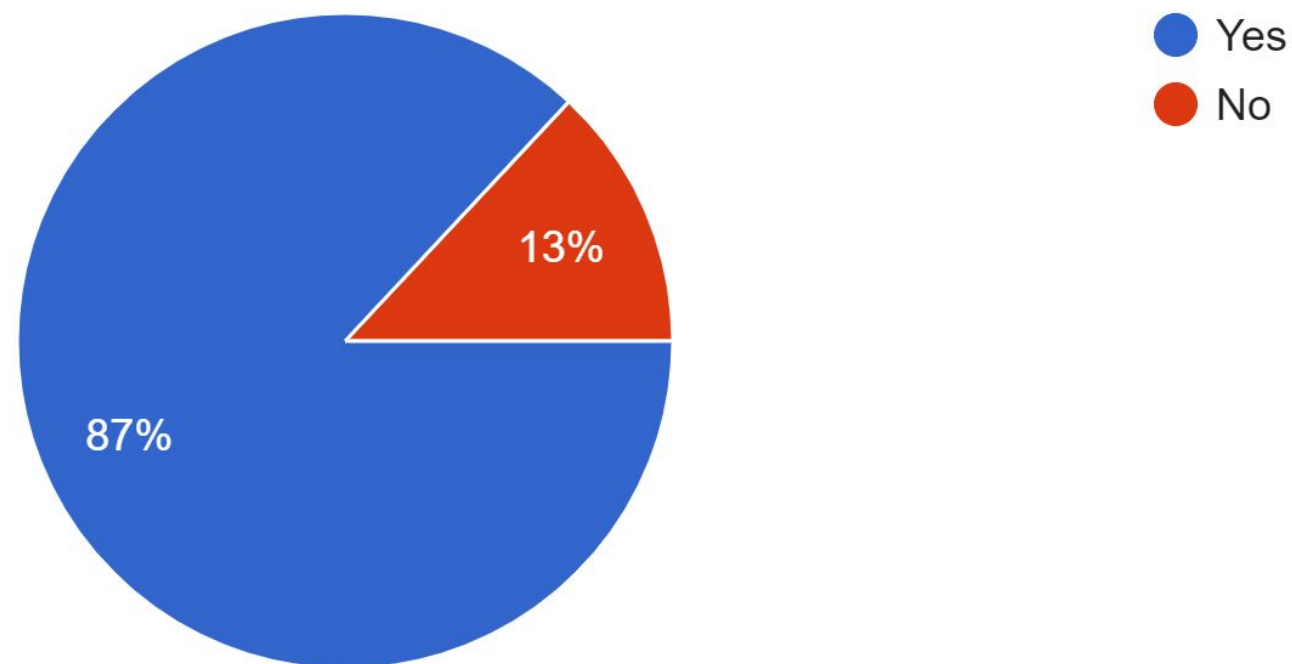
How often would you anticipate purchasing your child's lunch order during a given school week?

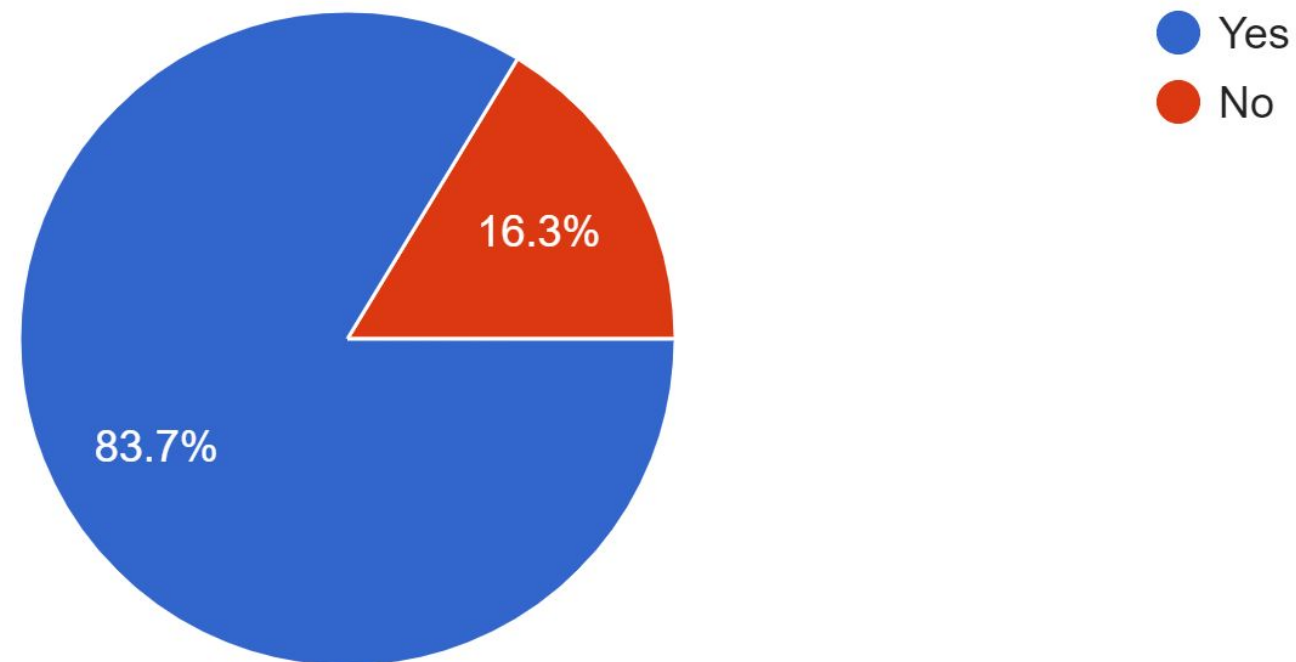

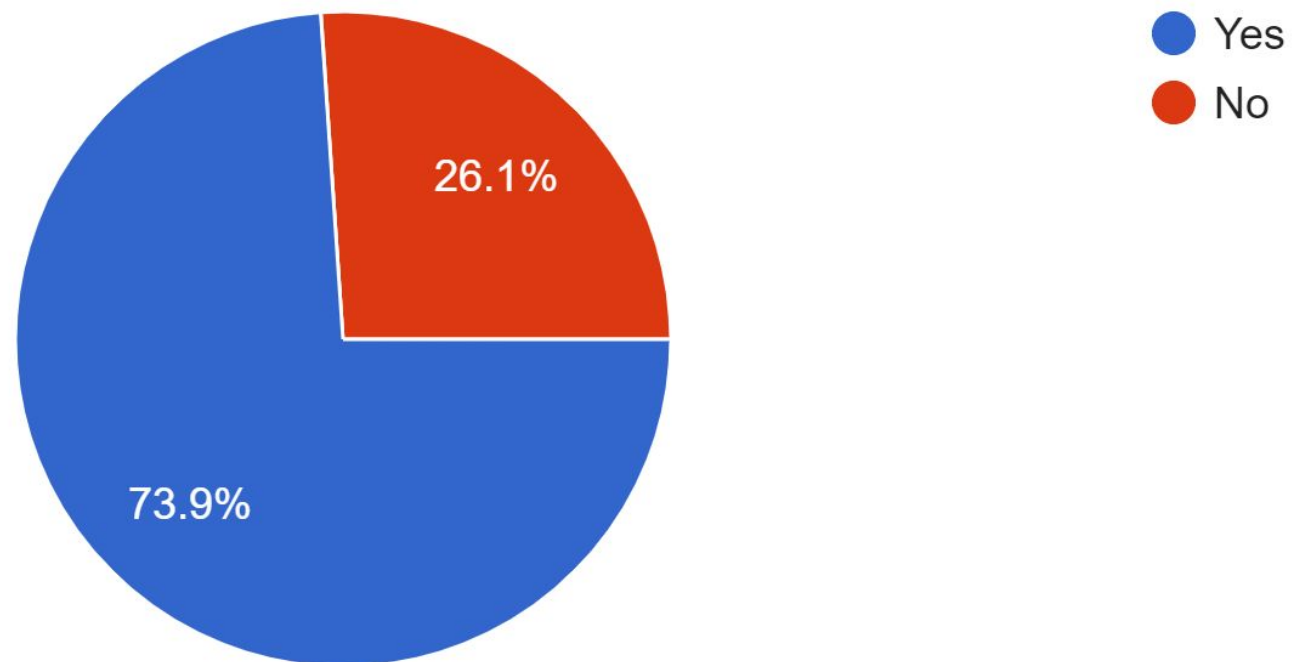
Would you pay the following prices for school lunch for your child: Grades 2 through 6 (\$6.00)

Safety Reminders

- Thank you for **driving safely and wearing your face coverings any time you are on campus** (5MPH on campus) We are limiting the amount of visitors at this time. 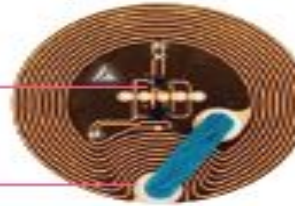

DETECTING THE HIDDEN FEVER¹

Researchers at Brown University and the Department of Veterans Affairs conducted a study assessing the average daily temperature of over 7,000 nursing home residents prior to and after COVID-19 testing.

They found that 73.4% of patients testing positive for SARS-CoV-2, never had a fever higher than 100.4° degrees Fahrenheit.

A single screening for temperature is unlikely to detect nursing home residents with SARS-CoV-2. Repeated temperature measurement with a patient-derived baseline can increase sensitivity.

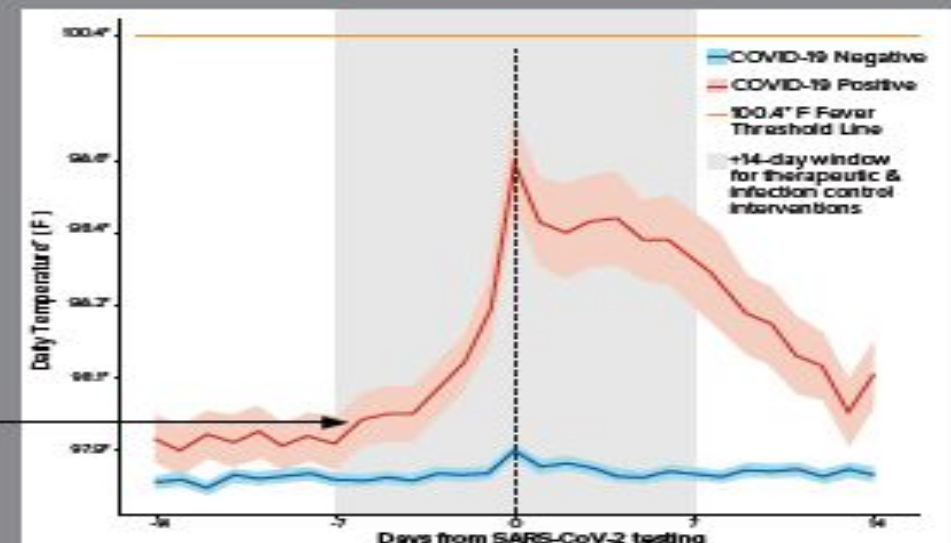


Fig. 1 Temperature in nursing home residents with and without SARS-CoV-2. The graph depicts daily temperature before (negative days) and after (positive days) the testing for SARS-CoV-2 (T0). The shaded area represents the 95% confidence intervals.
